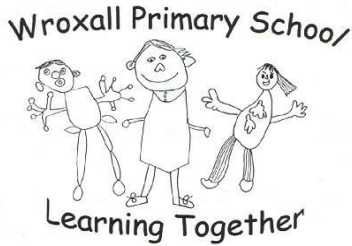

As you're probably aware, next week is a **National Assessment week for KS2, Year 6** children where they are required to take Standard Assessment Tests (SATs) in English and Maths.

Tests are required to be taken on specific days but the times of each are flexible in order to fit around the normal running of the school day:-

Monday 14th May English grammar, punctuation and spelling test - Paper 1 and 2.

Tuesday 15th May English Reading Test

Wednesday 16th May Mathematics Arithmetic Test Paper 1 and Paper 2, Reasoning

Thursday 17th May Mathematics Paper 3, Reasoning

As always, I will try to ensure that their experience of the week is 'like any other' and that they are well prepared – and hopefully, having been taught the potential content, enjoy the experience. I will do everything I can to alleviate any stress and will be telling the children how amazing they are whatever the outcome. After the tests we will all be glad to get on with the other important events that our children can shine at: Sports Day, end of year show and the school fete.
