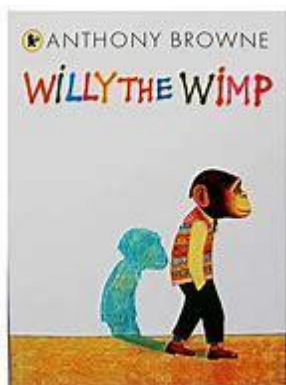
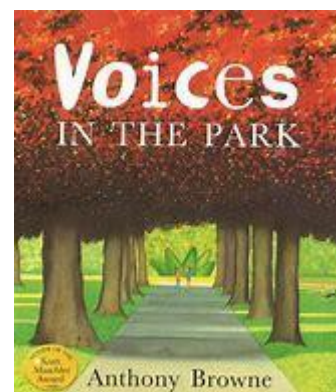


Browne Class Autumn 1 Newsletter 2021



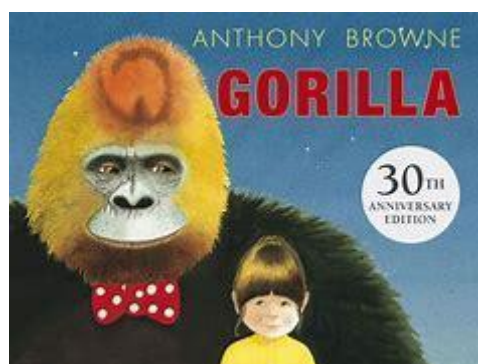
Dear Parents and Carers,
