Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you have all had a great time over the half term. The class have really impressed me in Autumn 1 and I can already see lots of progress in terms of learning and attitude. Curriculum

In Year 3/4 we aim to ensure that your child's curriculum develops key skills, encourages their creativity and embeds a joy of learning. Attached to this letter is a **medium term plan**, which provides an overview for this term. Reminders

- Children are expected to **read every day** at home, preferably to an adult. Homework records will be checked every day and rewards will be given for those who read.
- Questioning your child about their reading book is very important; it's not just about fluency. I will provide some prompt questions regarding the different areas of reading for those who want to provide further support at home.
- Please do not let your child bring in any toys or items from home as this only distracts them from their learning.
- The children do not need pencil cases in school, as we have all of the necessary resources within the classroom.
