<p>SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar)</p>	
<p>Check the SPAG we are doing this term</p> 	<p>Visit BBC Bitesize KS2 Grammar https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zwwp8mn and have a go at the pages.</p>
<p>Writing</p> 	<p>Generally, checking that when your child writes, they are using capital letters and full stops correctly to demarcate sentences.</p>
<p>Maths – tables</p> 	<p>It's really important that your child is as fluent as possible in multiplication tables – both the multiplication and division facts. The most effective way to do this is to ask them to complete TTRS at least 5 times a week. Each session only lasts for 15 minutes, but using it regularly really makes a difference.</p> <p>Your child will bring home a matching game during the term. Playing the game will be a great help to your child.</p>
<p>Reading</p> 	<p>Reading at least three times a week with your child will really help with fluency. Sometimes they will benefit from reading the same passage several times in the week. Ask your child questions about what they have read so you can check their understanding.</p>



We are learning about Earth in Space, the changing power of monarchs (specifically comparing Henry VIII with Charles III), and Frida Kahlo this term. It's quite a short term – only six weeks – so any additional research your child could do at home will really add to their understanding. It's always a pleasure to look at extra work children do in their own time, and they are able to share this with the class, which helps everyone.
