In 2021 the school benefited from a £2,000,000 renovation project which updated and expanded the school's provision, creating a modern and spacious learning environment.

Wroxall Primary have recently recruited a new Headteacher who will commence in post in September 2024, so this is an ideal time to join the school on its next adventure.
