### **School meals from September 2019**

This is an early update to let you know that school meal prices will increase slightly from September 2<sup>nd</sup> 2019. Meals are going up by 10p per meal. This means that a school dinner will then cost £2.05 per day (£10.25 per week). This does not affect the UIFSM entitlement to all children in Reception Class or KS1. However if your child is currently in Y2 and moves to Y3 in September please remember all meals provided for your child will be charged to your school money account. If this is proving costly, please complete the pupil premium form available from the school to check if you are / are not entitled for free school meals going into KS2. These forms can be completed at any time and not only offer family support, but also school support to support your child.
